•how to develop a comprehensive business plan so you can make an informed decision about the feasibility of starting your new business.

Each veteran is matched with his or her own mentor for individual guidance and support during the program. Mentors are successful entrepreneurs themselves.

During the last two weeks of the course, students finalize their business plan presentations with the assistance of instructors and mentors.
